Celebrating 10 years of extraordinary success, the UC Riverside School of Medicine (UCR SOM) is poised to enter a robust new era in its mission to grow and diversify Inland Southern California's physician workforce by completing its second state-of-the-art Medical Education Building. This was made possible through continued advocacy and leadership of our community as well as local and state legislators who worked tirelessly to promote the medical need and severe shortage of primary care and specialist doctors in Inland Southern California.

Complementing an array of significant accomplishments within the educational, research, clinical, and community components of the school, this innovative new teaching and learning resource stands as a concrete example of UCR's promise to bring quality health care to our fast-growing — and chronically underserved — Inland Southern California region.

We invite you to join us as a fellow visionary and philanthropic partner in this essential mission.

Recognizing the urgent need to address alarming gaps in health care accessibility within today's fastest-growing region in the country, the California state legislature made an early investment to fast-track the construction of our essential new medical education facility. Slated to open in fall 2023, this gleaming, five-story building will provide 57,000 assignable square feet of new instruction areas, study facilities, academic support spaces, and administrative offices, enabling UCR to boost the number of physicians in training up to 125 students per class.

With approval from state, regional, and UC system leaders, the UCR SOM will eventually grow enrollment from 328 to 500 medical students. To meet this ambitious goal, UCR seeks to rapidly expand and enhance our many regional partnerships, accelerate the growth of our UCR Health clinical enterprise, bolster funding for our world-class multidisciplinary research, and attract a new generation of forward-thinking philanthropic partners who believe in the bold vision and brilliant potential of our people, purpose, and mission.
